Open Call for Papers - Academic Publications

Special Issue on Computer-Mediated Communication (CMC) and Social Media Corpora | 31st May 2023, *Research in Corpus Linguistics (RiCL)*.

Editors: Mario Cal Varela, Javier Fernández Polo and Ignacio M. Palacios Martínez (Universidade de Santiago de Compostela).

The aim of this special volume is to collect a representative body of state-ofthe-art research on corpora of computer-mediated and social media communication, and thus to showcase current research in this area. The specific topics which we would like to see addressed in this volume include:

1) Issues related to the design, building, annotation, storage, analysis and sharing of CMC and social media corpora.

2) Language-centred empirical research into CMC and social media phenomena from a broad perspective, including Sociolinguistics, (Critical) Discourse Analysis, Pragmatics and Communication Sciences, among others.

3) Applications of corpus-based research into CMC and social media communication, for instance, in education.

As the first stage of submission, authors are asked to send a 600-word abstract of their proposal to the editors (ignacio.palacios@usc.es). This abstract should give a clear indication of the aims of the research, a succinct but sufficiently explicit indication of the theoretical underpinnings/background, the data and methods used, plus the main findings and implications of the study (either theoretical or applied).

The work should not have been previously published in English or any other language.

Timeline: Submission of title and abstract (of 600 words, excluding references) + author info: 31 May 2023

Notification of acceptance of the abstract, and invitation to authors to submit a full paper: 15 June 2023

Submission of full papers: 31 October 2023

Round 1 peer review - completed: 31 December 2023

Submission of round 1 revision: 31 January 2024

Final acceptance based on review outcomes: 30 April 2024

Publication: July 2024
