Over the past few months, we have engaged in various public-facing events as part of our commitment to transferring our research activity and agenda to everyone, including outside academia.

- To commemorate the **European Researchers' Night**, our InterGedi team took part in three parallel events on the 26th and the 27th of September:
 - Dr María Fanlo-Piniés participated in [the dissemination event held in Huesca](#), organised by *Unidad de Cultura Científica* (UCC) of the University of Zaragoza within the framework of the European project [G9-SCIENCE4ALL](#).
 - At [CaixaForum](#) (Zaragoza), our PhD candidates Luis Martínez-Kleiser, Lucía Lasheras-Bielsa and Ana E. Sancho-Ortiz participated in the Storytelling, the Speed Dating and the Late Show activities that were part of the event organised by [ESCIENCIA](#) and [Fundación "la Caixa"](#). They had a great time giving visibility to our project and raising awareness of the importance of language research to communicate expertise successfully to the wider public.

- October kicked off with our [IEDIS workshop](#), which took place on Friday the 3rd. Dr Pilar Mur-Dueñas, Dr Silvia Murillo and Dr Daniel Pascual ran a **4-hour training workshop** open to the whole IEDIS community. The aim was for participants to learn research-based, multimodal mechanisms that would help them curate their social media activity and boost their

communicative skills when disseminating specialised knowledge in English on digital platforms.
